Bill Summary: This proposal allows the county commission, or a county officer designated by the county commission, to take or process applications for passports or their renewal.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Revenue** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at the **Platte County Board of Election Commission** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at **St. Louis County** and the **Callaway County Commission** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

FISCAL ANALYSIS (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
