Bill Summary: This proposal expands the authority of the Governor to convey easements without the approval of the General Assembly and expands the rights granted by the easements.

• No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives**, the **Missouri Senate**, the **Office of Administration** and the **Office of the Governor** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
