Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

In response to a similar proposal from 2015 (HB 218), officials from the **St. Louis County Police** assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
