Officials at Jackson County, Clay County, the Kansas City Local Election Authority and the Clay County Board of Election Commission did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes this proposal is permissive in nature and would have no local fiscal impact without action by the governing body and approved by the majority of voters. The proposal does not preempt Kansas City from adopting certain property-related ordinances and registration fees to then be decided by a majority vote of the people.
