depository institution and changes the amount a tenant can recover when

the security deposit is wrongfully withheld.

Officials from the City of Kansas City, Callaway County and St. Louis County assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their local political subdivision.

There could be a direct fiscal impact to small businesses and residential landlords as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
