ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Social Services - State Technical Assistance Team, Cole County Sheriff's Department, Columbia Police Department, Boone County Sheriff's Department, and the Springfield Police Department each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Conservation** assume the proposal would have an unknown fiscal impact on the department.

Officials from the Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, Cass County Sheriff's Department, Clark County Sheriff's Department, Jackson County Sheriff's Department, Independence Police Department, St. Joseph Police Department, St. Charles Police Department, and the St. Louis County Police Department did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes state and local law enforcement agencies would be able to implement the changes in this proposal without incurring a material fiscal impact.
