FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Higher Education** assume that posting any required information on the department's website can be done with existing resources.

Officials at the **Metropolitan Community College** assume recurring costs of \$481,000. The recurring costs include \$45,000 to contract with an on-line training company, \$5,000 for face-to-face programs and \$431,000 for counselor's at all five campuses. One time costs of \$6,000 expected for a tracking system for training participates.

Officials at the **State Technical College of Missouri** and the **University of Missouri** each assume there would be a minimal impact on their respective institutions.

Officials at the **University of Central Missouri** assume no fiscal impact as they already have policies in compliance with this proposal.

Officials at the **Jefferson College** assume the College already has much of this information in place, therefore they expect little to no fiscal impact.

Officials at the **Missouri State University** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight notes this proposal requires the higher education institutions to post information and educational materials regarding depression and suicide prevention on their institution's website. The information is to include warning signs and where to get help. Oversight assumes the posting of this information can be done within each institution using existing resources. This proposal does not require students to participate in any training.

Officials at the following colleges: Crowder, East Central Community College, Harris-Stowe, Lincoln University, Moberly Area Community College, Missouri Southern State University, Missouri Western State University, Northwest Missouri State University, Southeast Missouri State University, State Fair Community College, St. Charles Community College, St. Louis Community College, Three Rivers Community College and the Truman State University did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
