FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at **Jefferson County** estimates this proposal will reduce absentee envelopes by 10,000 and will result in a net savings of \$5,000 per election.

Oversight assumes this savings to be minimal and will not reflect it in the fiscal note.

Officials at the St. Louis County Board of Election Commission, Callaway County, Buchanan County and the Platte County Board of Election Commission each assume no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State** and **Cole County** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective organizations.

Officials at the following boards of election commissioners: Kansas City Board of Election Commission, St. Louis City Board of Election Commission, Clay County Board of Election Commission, and Jackson County Board of Election Commission did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
