ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **State Tax Commission**, the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, **St. Louis County** and **Kansas City** assume this proposal will have no impact on their organizations.

Oversight is unable to determine how many mining properties would be reclassified and assessed based upon how the real property is currently being used. Oversight assumes only local revenues at an immaterial amount would be affected by this proposal and will show no financial impact.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposal provides that any real property that is available for mining but has not been bonded or permitted for such mining activity shall be assessed as agricultural and horticultural property.
