Bill Summary: This proposal modifies regulation of autocycle operators and exempts such operators from using protective headgear and also addresses load and length limits for transportation system.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Transportation** and **Department of Revenue** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** assumed the proposal would not have a fiscal impact on their organization.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
