FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System (LAGERS)** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on the system. It is anticipated to have no cost, with a potential cost savings to the local governments by effectively transitioning legacy plan administration into LAGERS. The decision to elect LAGERS administration is voluntary to local governments.

Officials from the **County of St. Louis**, the **County of Callaway**, and the **City of Kansas City** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Oversight assumes this proposal is discretionary and would have no local fiscal impact without action by the governing body.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
