Bill Summary: This proposal modifies provisions relating to abortion, including donation

of fetal tissue, tissue reports, abortion reports, physician privileges, and

ambulatory surgical center licensing and inspections.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources. The AGO may seek additional appropriations if the proposal results in a significant increase in litigation.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Corrections**, the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services**, the **Office of State Courts Administrator** and the **Office of State Public Defender** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
