In response to similar legislation this year, HCS for HB 2502, officials from the **University of Missouri** stated the proposed legislation has been reviewed and it has been determined that, as written, it should not create an additional expense in excess of \$100,000 annually.

Oversight assumes this is the materiality threshhold for the UM Health Care and that any costs incurred by UM can be absorbed within current resource levels.
