Bill Summary: This proposal modifies provisions regarding professional nursing and collaborative practice arrangements.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

The proposal may positively impact small business physicians offices by allowing both registered professional nurses and advanced practice registered nurses to have prescriptive authority. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
