## Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** defer to Department of Transportation for fiscal impact.

Officials from the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Department of Transportation, the Department of Mental Health, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, and the Department of Social Services each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
