Subject: Insurance - Health; Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration; Health Care

Bill Summary: This proposal specifies that a managed care plan's network shall be deemed adequate if the plan is offered by a health carrier accredited by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** defer to Department of Transportation for fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan**, the **Department of Transportation**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, and the **Department of Social Services** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
