**Bill Summary:** This proposal allows sheriffs and deputies to assist in other counties throughout the state.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Boone County Sheriff's Office** each assume the proposal would not create a fiscal impact to their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Cole County Sheriff's Office** state the proposal would not create a fiscal impact that the sheriff does not choose to encumber.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
