FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, the Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of the State Public Defender, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, and the Springfield Police Department each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC)** assume an unknown negative fiscal impact due to the uncertainty of the expense to purchase digital storage space and policies to deal with all the images recorded.

Oversight assumes the MDC could absorb any additional responsibilities resulting from this proposal with existing resources.

Officials from the **Cole County Sheriff's Office** state while some fiscal impact exists, it is not significant.

In response to a previous version of the proposal, officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Office** assumed the proposal would not create a fiscal impact to their agency.

In response to a previous version of the proposal, officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assumed that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

In response to a previous version of the proposal, officials from the **Cole County Sheriff's Office** stated the proposal would not create a fiscal impact that the sheriff does not choose to encumber
