ASSUMPTION

Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

In response to a similar proposal from last session, SS for SB 457, officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.
