**Bill Summary:** This proposal provides that a person who removes an unattended child

from a locked car shall not be held liable for damages.

### Fiscal Analysis

**Oversight** was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the Boone County Sheriff's Department, Columbia Police Department, Springfield Police Department and the Jefferson City Police Department each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Officials from the Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, Cass County Sheriff's Department, Clark County Sheriff's Department, Cole County Sheriff's Department, Independence Police Department, Jackson County Sheriff's Department, Platte County Sheriff's Department, St. Charles Police Department, St. Joseph Police Department, St. Louis County Police Department, St. Louis County Justice Services and the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
