FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **St. Louis County** assume the sales of non-rescue pets in retail establishments would have the potential to drive adopters away from the County's animal adoption center and toward the purchase of a pet. Estimating a potential loss of 600 adoptions plus 1,000 releases to rescue groups and a cost of \$200 per animal to capture, house and euthanize it, it would cost the County \$360,000 per year.

Oversight assumes other local political subdivisions in Missouri could face the same situation as St. Louis County. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a greater than \$360,000 per year to local political subdivisions.

Officials at the **Department of Agriculture** and the **Department of Conservation** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at the **Callaway County Commission** and the **City of Kansas City** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

This could have a direct fiscal impact to small businesses as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
