Oversight notes this proposal changes in statutes the term "guidance counselor" to "school counselor". Oversight is not aware of additional certification requirements for school counselors as opposed to guidance counselors. Oversight found the terms are often used interchangeably. Oversight assumes this proposal would not have a fiscal impact.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the Everton, Forsyth R-III, Kansas City and West Plains school districts each assume there is no fiscal impact to their respective district.

In response to the original version of this proposal, officials at Macon County R-IV, New Haven, Pettis County R-XII, Sarcoxie R-II, Webster Groves, and the Wright City R-II school districts each assumed there was no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective districts.
