In response to a similar proposal from this year (HB 2104), officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Alcohol and Tobacco Control (DPS - ATC)** assumed changes to Section 311.205 of the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Oversight assumes changes to Section 311.373 will not have direct fiscal impact on DPS-ATC.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.
