FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** assume this would be a new position in the Kansas City Police Department (KCPD). Unless the new position is absorbed by the current KCPD budget, the City will be asked to fund an additional Lieutenant Colonel position.

According to §84.510, the base annual compensation for Lieutenant Colonels is between \$71,969 and \$99,660. **Oversight** inquired the City of Kansas City regarding this position. This new position would start at the \$71,969 with benefits of \$10% annually. The following is the cost of this new position:

FY 17 (10 months)	\$65,972
FY 18	\$79,958
FY 19	\$80,757

Oversight will reflect a \$0 or the cost of the position for each fiscal year for this proposal since it is uncertain if the position will be absorbed into the KCPD's budget.

Officials at the **Department of Public Safety** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

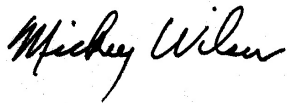
FISCAL DESCRIPTION
