Subject: Children and Minors; Courts; Domestic Relations; Family Law; Marriage and Divorce

Bill Summary: This proposal requires the court to enter written findings of fact and conclusions of law for matters pertaining to child support and child custody.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Oversight assumes this proposal reflects a change codifying statute and should have no direct fiscal impact to the proposal.

FISCAL ANALYSIS (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
