FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Kansas City Election Board** assume this proposal will have a minimal impact on their election budgets. They anticipate election expenses may increase by \$100 per election.

Officials from the Office of the Secretary of State, St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners, Platte County Board of Elections and Buchanan County each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight assumes this proposal would not have an impact unless an emergency was declared and the emergency workers requested absentee ballots. Oversight assumes the local election authorities could provide those absentee ballots within their existing resources and therefore, this proposal would not have a fiscal impact.

Officials at the following boards of election commissioners: St. Louis City Board of Election Commissioners, Clay County Board of Election Commissioners and Jackson County Board of Election Commissioners did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

Officials at the following counties: Andrew, Atchison, Boone, Camden, Carroll, Christian, Clay, Cole, Cooper, Daviess, Franklin, Knox, Marion, Miller, Montgomery, New Madrid, Phelps, Platte, and Wayne did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
