FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development**, **Office of the State Treasurer** and **Missouri State University** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** assume any expenses incurred by members serving on the commission can be absorbed.

Oversight assumes an unknown amount has been designated for state appropriations to the Ozark Exploration Bicentennial Fund, but estimates the amount to be less than \$100,000. State funds appropriated for this proposal would result in a transfer-out to the applicable fund.

Oversight assumes no federal funds have been appropriated to the Ozark Exploration Bicentennial Fund.

Oversight assumes all moneys coming into the Ozark Exploration Bicentennial Fund will be spent on Commission activities and will net to zero.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act creates the Ozark Exploration Bicentennial Commission, with membership as outlined in the act. The act creates the "Ozark Exploration Bicentennial Fund" to hold any state or federal appropriations, gifts, or other moneys for use by the Commission. The duties of the Commission include organizing and coordinating efforts relating to the bicentennial celebration of the exploration of the Ozarks by Henry Rowe Schoolcraft in 1819 as well as promoting public awareness of the significance of his exploration.

The Commission shall be dissolved on June 30, 2019.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
