FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Under current law, whenever any vacancy occurs in any office filled by election, other than the offices of Lieutenant Governor, state senator, state representative, sheriff, or St. Louis City Recorder of Deeds, the Governor is responsible for appointing a successor until the next election. This proposal modifies that provision so that vacancies in any county office of a noncharter county shall be immediately filled by the county commission. In the event that the county commission consists of two members who cannot come to an agreement on an appointee, the presiding commissioner shall fill the vacancy. Such appointees shall continue in office until the Governor appoints a person to serve out the remainder of the term.

This proposal does not apply to any charter county or to the offices of any prosecuting attorney or circuit attorney.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
