Bill Summary: This proposal requires health insurers to update their electronic and paper dental services provider materials available to plan members and potential members.

State Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan**, the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Department of Transportation** and the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
