Bill Summary: This proposal modifies provisions relating to ticket selling practices.

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

In response to a similar proposal from 2017 (HB 255), officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assumed that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
