There could be a direct fiscal impact to small businesses as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act creates a definition for the term "employee" and repeals the definition for the term "physician employee" in provisions relating to causes of action for damages against a health care provider for personal injury or death.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
