FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator (OSCA)** assume the proposed legislation allows the circuit court in St. Louis City to collect a fee not to exceed twenty dollars, rather than fifteen, to go toward the law library. During the past four years, there was an average of 4,157 circuit civil case filings, 7,368 domestic relations civil case filings and 19,010 associate civil and small claims civil case filings, for a total of 30,535. Based upon the increase in the collection fee not to exceed \$20, rather than \$15, to go toward the library, OSCA estimates the increase to be \$0 to \$152,675 (\$5 x 30,535).

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

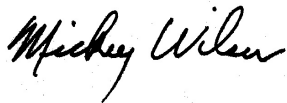
FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Currently, the circuit court in Jackson County and any circuit court in a circuit which reimburses the state for family court commissioners' salaries may collect a fee not to exceed twenty dollars in civil cases, which shall go towards the maintenance and upkeep of the law library in the designated county. This act provides that the circuit court in St. Louis City may also collect a fee not to exceed twenty dollars.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
