Officials at the School District of **West Plains R-VII** assume this proposal would not have a fiscal impact to their organization; however, in response to a previous version of this proposal (1356-01), it was assumed the proposal would have a negative fiscal impact related to annual software costs estimated at \$10,000 to \$20,000.

Oversight did not show a fiscal impact to the response received for the previous version (1356-01) from West Plains R-VII, based on the assumption additional software costs could be absorbed with existing resources. Also, officials at West Plains R-VII did not provide support for the estimated costs or why the costs would need to be ongoing.

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
