FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§379.321 - Commercial and Property Insurance Filing Requirements

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration (DIFP)** assume the policy amendments for certain lines of commercial and property insurance would no longer be required to be submitted to the department for review along with a \$50 filing fee. A loss of revenues to the Insurance Dedicated Fund would vary based upon the number of yearly filings but is estimated to be under \$100,000.

Bill as a whole

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Public Safety, Missouri State Highway Patrol, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Department of Social Services, the Office of Administration, Division of Accounting and the Administrative Hearing Commission, the St. Louis County Department of Justice Services and the Springfield Police Department each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the following **law enforcement agencies**: the Ashland Police Chief, Boone County Sheriff's Department, Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, Cass County Sheriff's Office, Clark County Sheriff's Department, Columbia Police Department, Independence Police Department, Jackson County Sheriff's Department, Jefferson City Police Department, Platte County Sheriff's Department, St. Charles Police Department, St. Joseph Police Department, St. Louis County Police Department and the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact.

Officials from **Carroll County** and the **City of Richmond** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact.
