Bill Summary: This proposal provides that a doctoral degree from programs accredited or provisionally accredited by the Psychological Clinical Science Accreditation System are acceptable for licensure as a psychologist if the program meets certain requirements.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

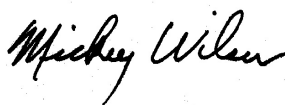
Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Department of Higher Education**, the **University of Central Missouri**, the **Missouri Western State University**, the **Northwest Missouri State University**, the **Missouri State University** and the **State Technical College of Missouri** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
