Subject: Elderly; Health and Senior Services Department; Nursing Homes and Long-term Care Facilities

Bill Summary: This proposal requires long-term care facilities to institute policies facilitating familial involvement in the well-being and support of its residents.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

This proposal may have a minimal negative administrative fiscal impact on small business long-term care facilities. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
