Bill Summary: This proposal applies all current motorcycle and all-terrain vehicle franchise practice provisions to “powersport vehicles.”

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission**, the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Transportation** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

A fiscal impact to small businesses could be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
