Oversight assumes no fiscal impact from this amendment.

In response to a previous version, officials at the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Office of the Secretary of State and the Office of the Governor each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at **Boone County** and the **Platte County Board of Election Commission** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

In response to similar legislation from 2017, HCS for HB 54, officials at the **Callaway County Commission** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to similar legislation from this year, SB 665, officials at **Buchanan County** and the **Lincoln County Clerk's Office** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials at the Clay County Board of Election Commissioners did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.
