ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health (DMH)** state the DMH assumes no fiscal impact should this legislation pass. Disproportionate Share Hospital payments generates approximately \$130 million in additional revenues for the state.

Officials from the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of Administration, the Office of State Courts Administrator and the Office of State Public Defender each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
