FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **University of Missouri System** have determined that they are not able to estimate costs with certainty but anticipate it could be significant to the university.

Oversight will show a fiscal impact of \$0 to an unknown cost to public institutions of higher education.

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator (OSCA)** assume there may be some impact but there is no way to quantify that currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget requests.

Officials from the **State Technical College of Missouri** assume an unknown impact.

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education** and **Missouri Western State University** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials at the following colleges: Crowder, East Central Community College, Harris-Stowe, Jefferson College, Lincoln University, Metropolitan Community College, Moberly Area Community College, Missouri Southern State University, Missouri State University, Northwest Missouri State University, Southeast Missouri State University, State Fair Community College, St. Charles Community College, St. Louis Community College, Three Rivers Community College, Truman State University and the University of Central Missouri did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act creates the "Academic Freedom and Whistleblower Protection Act", which prohibits any public institution of higher education from creating or maintaining a policy that allows the institution to take adverse personnel action against a faculty member for certain acts of expression, as described in the act.

Any person whose rights under this act are violated may bring an action in any state court of competent jurisdiction. Such action must be filed not later than one year after the day the cause of action accrues, as described in the act.

The provisions of this act do not apply to any privately operated institution of higher education.

This act contains an emergency clause.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
