FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **St. Louis County Election Board** assume the fiscal impact from this proposal is approximately \$10,000.

In response to a similar proposal, SB 133 (LR 0706-01) from 2017, **Office of the Secretary of State** assumed there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight notes this proposal would impact school districts in St. Louis County. Those school districts are Affton, Bayless, Brentwood, Clayton, Ferguson-Florissant, Hazelwood, Jennings, Kirkwood, Ladue, Lindbergh, Maplewood-Richmond Heights, Mehlville, Normandy, Parkway, Pattonville, Ritenour, Riverview Gardens, Rockwood, Special School District of St. Louis County, University City, Valley Park and Webster Groves school districts.

Officials at the following school districts: Hazelwood, Lindbergh, Maplewood-Richmond Heights, Mehlville, Parkway, Pattonville, Riverview Gardens, Rockwood, Special School District of St. Louis County, Valley Park and Webster Groves school districts did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act requires the Board of Election Commissioners to establish, within St. Louis County, seven subdistricts for any school district that is within or adjoining another school district that itself is within, in whole or in part, a street light maintenance district with a population less than 3,000. The subdistricts shall be established for the purposes of electing directors of the first mentioned school district. The subdistricts shall be drawn as set forth in the act. The requirements of the elected members of the board are set forth in the act.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
