#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **Office of the Adjutant General** and the **Department of Economic Development** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

**Oversight** notes this proposal extends the time a person eligible for benefits under the Show-Me Heroes Program could receive benefits. Currently, a person is entitled to benefits for one year and this proposal extends it to five years. Oversight notes this proposal does not require additional appropriations and therefore, Oversight will not show a fiscal impact.

The Show-Me Heroes Program provides active duty National Guard members and recently separated United States military personnel and their spouses with job training and financial assistance to gain new employment. The program promotes the hiring of veterans and encourages employers to consider veterans. It also provides on-the-job training opportunities to those recently returned from deployment and those recently separated from active duty. The Department of Economic Development administers the program and it has received \$500,000 per year in funding the last three years.
