**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration (DIFP)** estimate up to 391 insurers would be required to submit amendments to their policies to comply with legislation. Policy amendments must be submitted to the department for review along with a \$50 filing fee. One time additional revenues to the Insurance Dedicated Fund are estimated to be up to \$19,550.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health and the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
