FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** and **Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Summersville R2 School District** assume a negative fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Kirksville R-III School District** assume a slight negative fiscal effect on the district.

Officials from the City of Springfield, City of Kansas City, Wellsville-Middletown R-1 School District, West Plains School District and Northeast Nodaway R-5 School District assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Oversight notes that school bus drivers are required to undergo a criminal background check before being allowed to operate a school bus. Some school districts may contract with municipalities or other entities to provide school buses. This proposal clarifies that any person who drives a school bus, whether the bus is operated by the school district, a transportation company, a municipality or any other entity must all undergo that criminal background check.

Oversight is unable to determine if any school districts currently contact for school bus drivers that have not undergone the criminal background check. Oversight notes the criminal background check is performed by the Missouri Highway Patrol and they charge a fee for the background check. Oversight assumes the Missouri Highway Patrol may have to complete additional background checks; however, Oversight assumes the number to be minimal and will not show a fiscal impact for this proposal.
