ASSUMPTION

§§571.101 and 571.170 - Concealed carry weapons

Oversight contacted the **Department of Public Safety** and **Department of Revenue** regarding the number of active CCW permits or lifetime permits issued in Missouri. Oversight was not able to obtain this information since permits are handled through each county's sheriff's department.

Oversight notes that the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol**, **Office of State Courts Administrator**, **City of Columbia**, **City of Kansas City**, **City of Springfield** and **Boone County Sheriff's Department** have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties and sheriffs' departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
