#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

The vendor has to document that the attendant was present and providing the services set forth in the plan of care. If the attendant is not present or providing necessary services, the provider must notify the Department of Health and Senior Services.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
