FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Sherwood-Cass R-VIII School District** assume the cost to the school districts would be the loss of revenue from hosting competitions, concession sales, and miscellaneous revenues through fund-raising and other methods.

Officials from the **Springfield Public Schools** assume a cost of \$75,000 for administrative support to monitor eligibility and other factors for students who are not enrolled in the district and other costs that would result from expanded need for contests due to increased participation. The district has 14 schools with athletics so this would require dedicated staff time.

Officials from the **Lee's Summit R-7 School District** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization as the Missouri State High School Activities Association does have guidelines and our district does allow these students to participate.

Officials from the **Wellsville-Middletown R-1 School District** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes the Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA) does allow some non-traditional students to participate if they meet certain criteria including in-class seat time per the MSHSAA Handbook; however, Oversight assumes that strictly home-schooled students would be ineligible to participate. Oversight notes some districts indicated a negative fiscal impact due to loss of revenue from hosting competitions, concession sales and fund-raising or administrative costs to track eligibility. Oversight will show an unknown cumulative fiscal impact to school districts that could exceed \$100,000.
