ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Public Safety** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight notes that the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety and the Office of the State Courts Administrator each has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials at the **Jackson County Sheriff's Office** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to similar legislation from this session, SB 12, officials at **Boone County** and the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.
