**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources (DNR)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

DNR states the following amounts have been collected for geologic resources fees (\$256,700) and deposited into the Geologic Resources Fund (0801):

FY 2018	\$191,430
FY 2017	\$191,642
FY 2016	\$175,037

**Oversight** notes the fund balance in the Geologic Resources Fund (0801) as of May 31, 2019 was \$336,655.

**Oversight** notes that the authority to collect the fees in Section 256.700, RSMo expires on December 31, 2020. This proposal extends that expiration date to December 31, 2025. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a revenue extension (continuance) of \$186,000 (average fee collected over the past three full fiscal years) beginning January 1, 2021 for this proposal.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Budget and Planning** assume this proposal has no impact on their organization, has no direct impact on General or Total State Revenues and will not impact the calculation pursuant to Article X, Section 18(e).
