ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Department of Economic Development (Public Service Commission (PSC) and the Office of Public Counsel), the Department of Corrections, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, the Office of Prosecution Services and the Office of the State Public Defender each assume the proposal will have no direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from PSC state that their office currently has 2 staff with security clearance to work with Missouri Information Analysis Center (MIAC) and therefore releasing records related to infrastructure security or cybersecurity to MIAC would not fiscally impact their organization.

Oversight notes that the agencies above has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
